**Introduction**

The Evelyn Russell Scholarship Fund was established in 2000 by the Christ Fellowship Church Women's Ministry. The Women's Ministry Advisory Board believed that honoring a founding member of the church, Mrs. Evelyn Russell, could best be demonstrated through a scholarship fund to enable the ongoing education of our youth. Mrs. Russell was a profound encourager of young men and women who pursued higher learning in order to achieve better careers, attain job-enhancing skills, and, more so, to become all that the Lord had created them to be. Thus, the Women's Ministry, through the sacrificial giving of church members, family members and friends, endeavors to award scholarships to deserving church youth to assist them in attaining their educational goals.

**Who May Apply**

The scholarship is available to members of Christ Fellowship Church who are selected for a scholarship award based on their meeting and fulfilling the scholarship award requirements.

**Scholarship Award Amount**

The number of successful applicants as well as the total dollar amount in the fund will determine the amount of the scholarship award(s).

**Scholarship Application Timeframe**

Completed applications, projects, essays, and supporting documentation are due no later than **23 June 2018** and should be submitted via e-mail to [ERSF@cfchurch.org](mailto:ERSF@cfchurch.org). ### **Scholarship Award Requirements**

- An applicant must be a member of Christ Fellowship Church, Herndon, VA.
- Applicants must provide proof of current enrollment or admission to an accredited institution of higher learning (e.g., letter of acceptance and registration; confirmation receipt of enrollment registration, etc.)
- Applicants must provide evidence of at least a "B" average (3.0 GPA) or above for the semester ending **March 2018 or June 2018** (e.g., student grade report). In the event that after high school, enrollment in a higher learning institution was delayed, records from within the last 12 months of the last date of high school enrollment will be accepted. Institutions of higher learning include colleges, universities or vocational schools.
- **College** applicants must submit a (1) two-page, double spaced, typed essay in APA format prepared by the applicant. **Vocational** applicants may submit a project and one-page essay, double spaced and typed in APA format. The response should focus on the Scholarship Questions attached. Please select one question and prepare an essay that includes footnotes, references, and endnotes as applicable.
